The inspiration comes from the life and work of Yan-Kit So (1933-2001), Britain's late leading authority on Chinese cuisine. Her seminal work *Classic Food of China* (1992) is a major contribution towards the understanding of Chinese regional food culture.

The Yan-Kit So Award is co-hosted by the Oxford Cultural Collective, an independent cultural institute that promotes better understanding of food and drink. The award is funded by philanthropic donations.
